## **SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE**

For the week of November 28-December 4, 2021

### "LIVING THE GENEROUS LIFE"

### **GETTING STARTED**

To the facilitator: Use this section to introduce the topic. If possible, give a brief recap of the sermon.

#### **GROUP DISCUSSION**

Read John 12:1-8. Matthew 26:6-12. Mark 14:3-11.

- In two separate columns, list out the differences you see between Mary's and Judas' heart. Which aspect of Mary's love comes easiest to you? Which aspect is most difficult for you?
- 2. Matthew and Mark places Judas' dark change of heart as happening immediately after Mary's extravagant act of love. According to the following verses, why are greed and the love of money so dangerous?

Matthew 6:24	
1 Timothy 6:9-10	
James 4:1-4	

- 3. Given the value of the perfume, if you were there, how would you have reacted as you watch Mary break the alabaster jar? How would you define the word "devotion"? Do you think is Mary's devotion is an act of worship?
- 4. How do the disciples react to Mary when she empties her bottle of perfume upon Jesus? (See also Matthew 26:8-9 and Mark 14:4-5.) What do you think were the reasons why they responded that way? What does this reveal about their hearts?
- 5. Do you relate to Mary's unabashed affection for Jesus? If so, what are some judgments or misconceptions you've suffered as a result? If not, what are some things that might be keeping you from this type of affection?
- Have you ever calculated or considered what it should cost you to follow Jesus? In what ways have you found Jesus to be worth what it has cost? Are there areas of

your life where your affection for Jesus isn't in alignment with the worth you say you place on him?
