SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

"DON'T JUST GO TO CHURCH!"

ETTING STARTER

GETTING STARTED

To the facilitator: Use this section to introduce the topic. If possible, give a brief recap of the sermon.

Share a memorable point, a spiritual lesson, a personal application, a question, or something that challenged you from the sermon last Sunday.

If you were to be invited to the White House tomorrow to have dinner with the U.S. President, what preparations will you make?

GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Ecclesiastes 5:1-7

- 1. This text starts out by telling us to guard our steps when we go to house of God. Is this something that you have thought much about? How would you describe your typical mindset as you prepare to worship with your Living Word church family?
- 2. The word "fool" is repeated several times in our text (v.1,3,4). Why does the Teacher (writer of Ecclesiastes) say about the errors of the fool when he goes to the house of God?
- 3. Why do you think there is so much emphasis in this text on our speech? What do our words reveal about us? (See also Proverbs 25:11-12, James 3:9-10, Ephesians 4:29, Titus 3:1-2.)
- 4. Far too often, we treat God casually and we forget that he is an eternal God. How would it look like giving God the reverence he deserves as we gather for worship?
- 5. What is the advice given in verses 4-6 for those making vows? Have you ever made a commitment to God with a genuine intention of following through it? If not, how can you or your small group help support you in your pursuit of being faithful to your yows before the Lord?
- 6. Does your relationship with God have a P.S. attached to it? Or have you ever "bribed" God to do your bidding? How does it look like committing your service, time, and resources to the Lord without expecting anything in return?

7. The passage ends with the admonishment to stand in awe of God. What causes you to be in awe of God? In reflection, would you honestly say that this is still true of you or are you suffering from "awe" problem? What do you think is the reason?

8. **NEXT STEPS**
