SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

For the week of April 16-22, 2023 "ICYMI: SALVATION (PART 1)"

GETTING STARTED

To the facilitator: Use this section to introduce the topic. If possible, give a brief recap of the sermon.

Share a memorable point, a spiritual lesson, a personal application, a question, or something that challenged you from the sermon last Sunday.

What would you consider a great birthday gift to receive personally? Why?

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. According to Ephesians 2:8-9, what is the role of grace and faith in salvation? Why do you think good works are not mentioned as a requirement for salvation? How does this passage challenge the common belief that individuals can earn their way into heaven?
- 2. What does Acts 4:12 mean when it says, "There is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved"? Why is it important for Christians to believe in the exclusivity of salvation through Jesus Christ?
- 3. How would you define "repentance"? Do you think most Christians think much about repentance? How do you know if repentance is real? What results do you expect from genuine repentance?
- 4. Read Luke 12:8-10. Jesus mentions one form of hypocrisy which the Pharisees were guilty of that can never be forgiven. What is it? Why can't it be forgiven?
- 5. Christianity claims that Jesus Christ is the only way to salvation and his sacrifice on the cross is sufficient to redeem man from sin. Why do you think this is so contentious? Why do you think many people believe in "many ways to heaven" and what is the problem with this logic?
- 6. Application. How should our understanding of salvation as grace impact our relationship with God and others? What implications does this passage have on how we treat those who don't know or are even against Jesus?

7. NEXT STEPS

- Pray for protection, provision, healing and comfort for everyone who's going through physical, emotional, mental and spiritual pain.
